In 2009 Highlands won a position on the North Carolina Small Town Main Street Program to help us improve the look of our downtown and promote its identity. Last year the Program was making progress when the State cut our budget, but the Town Board felt it was such an important project that they voted to fund it this Winter and Spring.
